The Epiphany of the Lord

My dear parishioners,

This week the Church has given a moving farewell to Emeritus Pope Benedict XVI. As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany, I offer these words from Benedict, 'the saintly scholarly Pope', as Archbishop Rowan Williams liked to call him:

"Men and Women of every generation need on their pilgrim journey to be directed: what star can we therefore follow? After coming to rest "over the place where the child was", the purpose of the star that guided the Magi ended, but its spiritual light is always present in the Word of the Gospel, which is still able today to guide every person to Jesus. This same Word, which is none other than the reflection of Christ, true man and true God, is authoritatively echoed by the church for every well-disposed heart. The Church too, therefore, carries out the mission of the star for humanity. But something of the sort could be said of every Christian, called to illuminate the path of the brethren by word and example of life." Pope Benedict XVI

At the beginning of this New Year, let us ask Jesus, the eternal Light, to help us to be a parish that carries on the mission of the star for all who walk through the doors of St. Mary's and St. Paul's; let us also ask Pope Benedict to assist us with his prayers from heaven.
