My dear parishioners,

This simple remark made me think about the beauty of the daily liturgy and what a gift it is to the community of the church. It is indeed a privilege to gather each morning to celebrate the eucharist in memory of Jesus; the daily liturgy also brings us into communion with many remarkable men and women, who have gone before us in the life of faith, through the celebration of the feast days of our saints. We become aware, more and more that the pilgrim church of Jesus continues to make its way through history.
